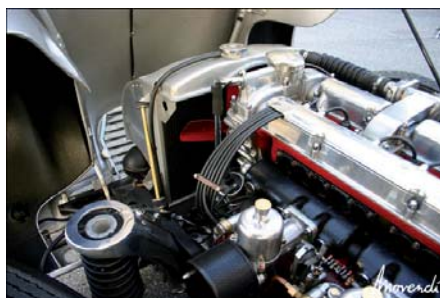

The Aston was fitted with later-type pistons and valve guides. The brakes were also modified with Alfin drums. The engine performance was improved and maybe that is the reason why this Aston Martin is so quick. The Aston Martin has undergone mechanical work on the engine, the gearbox, the rear axle, the brakes and the bodywork in 2003 and 2005. At the moment, the Aston Martin is driving extremely well.
